

#### HISTORY OF THE KALVESTA METHODIST CHURCH

A group of Christian people had been meeting for some time at the Kalvesta School house and in 1926 there was organized a Methodist class under the leadership of Rev. E. P. Rogers who was pastor at Cimarron at that time.

The following were chosen as Stewards for the new church:—George Monical, Chairman, Mrs. Zenobia Phelps, Secretary, O. P. Evans, Mrs. D. H. Holden, Gus Norton. The trustees elected were Fred Brown, Leonard Byler, D. H. Holden, M. A. Chapman, Ed Sultz. There were thirty charter members of the church. Of these the following are still members of the church:—Mrs. Susan Baldwin, Mrs. George Evans, Mr. D. H. Holden, Mr. and Mrs. Gus Norton, Mrs. E. B. Phelps, Mrs. Ivan Baldwin.

The church continued to meet at the school house until September 1, 1946 when services were first held in the new church building. The hour of the services was in the afternoon until June, 1946, when it was changed to nine-thirty A. M.

Plans for a church building began under the pastorate of Rev. M. B. Holcomb. In 1944-45 a school building was purchased, and the basement excavated for the new building. After the present pastor came the building was moved to the new church location and remodeled. Much of the work on the building was donated by friends and members. The ground for the building site was donated to the church by Mr. and Mrs. Gus Norton.

The church has been on the same charge as Cimarron except for one year when it was with Jetmore. This was the first year that Rev. H. E. Stipe served as pastor.
